

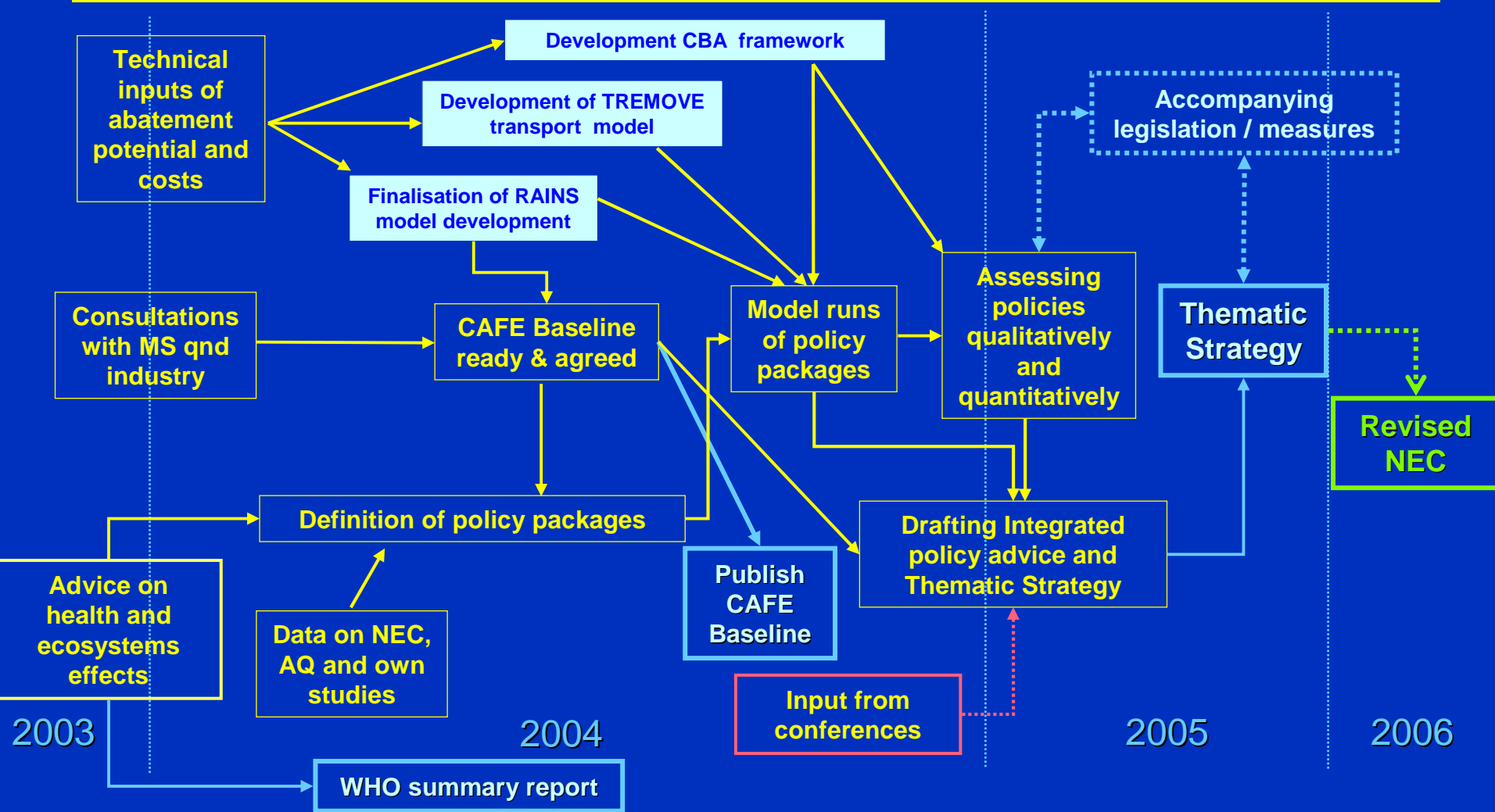
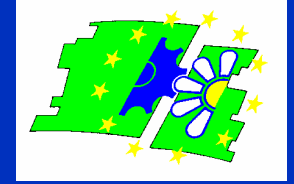

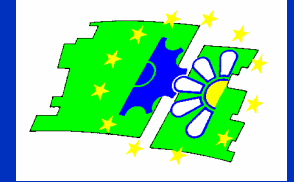


Schematic outline of CAFE timeline

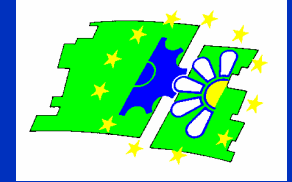


Preparing the Thematic strategy on air pollution

- **November CAFE SG advice on policy options**
- **February 2005 CAFE SG integrated policy advice**
- **1 April 2005 – TS to Commission Interservice Consultation**
- **May 2005 - CAFE SG and information on main policy packages**
- **June 2005 – TS adopted by Commission with proposals for legislation**



CAFE Steering Group May 2004: main discussions



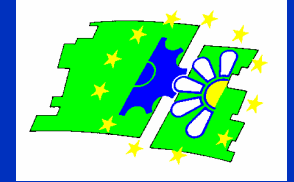
**Presentation of the first results of the Baseline scenario and
general reactions of the stakeholders**

First results of the Baseline shows:

- **Assuming a good implementation of existing legislation, drastic emission reductions for many sectors except ships, small scale combustion installations, agriculture, solvent industry**
- **Important uncertainties particularly for PM 10 and even more for PM 2.5**
- **Not proportional reduction of the effects of air pollution**



CAFE /EGTEI



- **EGTEI process has been useful and applied in CAFE as long as the data have been verified by the the stakeholders**
- **Commission considers the continuity of the EGTEI process as important and therefore is prepared to support it through different means in the short and the long term**
