Decisions of the WGSR of 2005 (1)

Clarification of the process of validation of EGTEI documents and their consideration into RAINS

- ◆ Approval of EGTEI documents to be taken at the WGSR meeting
- ◆ In case of structural modification of RAINS module, decision at the TFIAM and the Executive body EMEP

Decisions of the WGSR of 2005 (2)

Process followed for validation of EGTEI documents

- ◆ Synopsis sheets sent to heads of delegation to the WGSR by the UNECE secretariat
- ◆ Demand of comments in a delay of 4 months
- ◆ Comments taken into account if necessary and work re-opened if necessary
- ◆ In 2005/2006, 3 sectors concerned. Cement glass and refineries

EGTEI work carried out in 2006 (1)

- ◆ Closed cooperation with IIASA to define future priorities in works:
 - ü Small combustion plants, domestic wood burning industrial processes with PM emissions, steel production, emerging technologies, LCP
- ◆ Continuation of the work on LCP > 500 MWth (after comments of NGOs)
- ◆ Application of the LCP methodology by the Czech Republic and Sweden (probable extension to Finland and Denmark) (in 2007 for these ones)

EGTEI work carried out in 2006 (2)

- ◆ Work on small combustion installations carried out by Italy
- ◆ Working sessions with national experts (Belgium, Sweden)
- ◆ Set up of a work on emerging technologies (meeting of 12 April 2006)

EGTEI work carried out in 2006 (3)

- ◆ State of progress of the work on sectors submitted to approval by WGSR heads of delegation. In November 2006, the situation is :
 - Document on cement approved (Sept. 06)
 - Document on glass production to be reviewed to update some costs (but new demand for the BREF revision)
 - Document on refineries to be revised with an extended group of experts
 - Belgium is applying the methodology for refineries

EGTEI work carried out in 2006 (4)

- ◆ High implication of EGTEI in the work of EIPPCB (IPTS, Sevilla) for the BREF « Surface Treatment with Solvents ». Participation of EGTEI to the last TWG following a nomination from France. Participation to two meetings in Sevilla TWG. Provision of all EGTEI cost data
- ◆ BREF STS issued some days ago. An annex is included in the BREF with direct link to the EGTEI web site and synopsis sheets - Explanation on EGTEI and its limitation for the BREF
- ◆ For some activities, like wood preservation, direct use of EGTEI data to define BAT

EGTEI work carried out in 2006 (5)

- ◆ Preparatory work for the review of annexes IV, V and VI of the Gothenburg Protocol following the mandate of the Executive Body of December 2005.
- ◆ Declaration of intention presented to TFIAM in May 2006 in Rome and to the WGSR in September 2006 in Geneva

EGTEI work programme for 2007 (1)

- ◆ Review of annexes of the Gothenburg Protocol. Programme set up and adopted by the WGSR of 2006. The programme continues up to the second WGSR of 2007 in September
- ◆ In this context of the review of annexes, Finland supports a work on stationary engines
- ◆ Acceleration on the work on emerging technologies (meetings the 24 November 2006 in Marseille and the 3 April 2007 in Rome)
- ◆ Organisation by Kazakhstan of an EGTEI meeting in October 2007 with support of Poland

EGTEI work programme for 2007 (1)

- ◆ Revision / extension of the work for refineries
- ◆ Support of EGTEI in the determination of costs for glass industry for the BREF revision and update of the EGTEI document

EGTEI work programme for 2007 (1)

- ◆ Possible other issues to be discussed during the meeting :
 - ü Set up of a working group on wood combustion
 - ü Extension of the work on LCP to plants lower than 500 MW
 - ü Extension of the work done by Italy to other countries
 - ü Cross media impact of reduction techniques on CO2 emissions
 - ü Possible role of EGTEI in an advisory board for the revision of the Guide book EMEP/CORINAIR
